ARKANSAS WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM (AWP)

About AWP

The AWP Program was developed to help provide home improvements in homes that are severely-inefficient when it comes to energy use. The program will help customers find ways to reduce and make the most of the energy used every day. AWP is for anyone, regardless of income or type of home, who wants to improve the energy efficiency of their home.

How to Qualify for AWP

People with severely energy-inefficient homes may apply. The homes must be:

- Owned by residential customer of at least one of the AWP utilities listed above (customer must have their name on the deed)
- Site-constructed or mobile home
- Occupied by current owner for at least one year
- Built prior to 1983 and meeting three of the seven criteria listed in the next section
- Built from 1983 to 1996 and meeting four of the seven criteria listed in the next section

PLEASE NOTE: Homes built in 1997 or later do not qualify for the AWP program

Qualifying Criteria for Your Home

Depending on when your home was built, three or four of the following criteria must be met before your home is eligible for assistance from AWP.

1. [Attic insulation equal to or less than R-12](#)
2. [Wall insulation equal to R-0](#)
3. [Floor insulation equal to R-0](#)
4. [Single pane windows with no storm windows attached](#)
5. [Heating system less than 70 percent efficient](#)
6. [Cooling system with SEER of 8 or less](#)
7. [Air infiltration problems identified through:](#)
 - a. [Visual inspection of ductwork, wall, floors, ceilings, door, and windows](#)
 - b. [Pre-blower door test resulting in:](#)
 - i. [Greater than 2,200 CFM at 50 pa \(for households of 5 persons or less\)](#)
 - ii. [Greater than 2,700 CFN at 50 pa \(for households of more than 5 persons\)](#)

Pre and Post carbon monoxide (CO) readings must meet the health and safety regulations specified by the U.S. Department of Energy.

ARKANSAS WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM (AWP)

What AWP Does

The AWP Program makes use of computerized energy audits and uses advanced diagnostic technology to determine the energy-conservation needs of a home.

How AWP is Funded

Funding comes partially from the participating utility that supplies your home. The remaining amount will be a co-pay that the customer is required to pay. The co-payment from the customer must be paid prior to any audit or work is completed on the home. Payment must be made in the form of cash, cashier's check or money order.

Audit Costs

An energy audit will be performed on the home. This consists of blower door testing and carbon monoxide testing for all combustion appliances. Air infiltration leaks will be noted throughout the house. The attic, walls and floors will be checked for insulation. The efficiency of heating and cooling equipment and the refrigerator will also be noted. The results of the audit will then be entered in a computerized energy audit program, which will list recommended cost-effective measures to be used on the home to make it more energy efficient. The audit cost is \$456. Each participating utility that supplies energy to the home will pay 25% of each audit.

Example: For a household that uses two of the participating utilities, each utility will pay 25% of \$456, or \$114 each, leaving the customer to pay \$228 for the audit. However, if there is only one qualifying utility providing energy to the home, that utility will pay \$114 and the customer will pay the remaining \$342.

The customer co-payment must be made before the audit will be completed on the home. Audit recommendations are sent directly to the customer.

Cost of Recommended Measures

For customers that want to implement the recommended measures, a complete invoice with the itemized costs will be sent to the customer. Each participating utility that provides energy to the home will help with the cost, paying 25% of the cost, up to a total of \$741.

Example: Recommended measures cost \$2964. Two utilities provide energy to the home. Each utility will pay \$741 for a total of \$1482. The customer must pay \$1482. In the same example, if the cost of implementing recommended measures is \$2600 and only one utility provides energy to the home, the utility will pay \$741, and the customer will pay \$2223.

Payment must be made prior to any work being completed on the home and prior to any materials being ordered. If the cost of the recommended measures is less, the amount each utility will contribute will be a lesser amount. If the cost is greater, the utilities will not contribute any greater amount. The customer will be responsible for all that the utility does not pay. If the total job costs exceed \$5000, the project will not be eligible for any assistance through the AWP program. Each agency will have qualified contractors or personnel that will install the recommended measures to the home.

ARKANSAS WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM (AWP)

Results

After the energy conservation measures have been installed on the home, another blower door test will be completed. This test will indicate the amount of reduction in air infiltration, indicating the home is more energy efficient. A carbon monoxide test will also be completed to ensure that all combustion appliances are still operating safely.

The Benefits

The program helps individuals and families by making their home more secure from the weather, which helps to conserve energy and reduce energy bills for years to come. In addition, homes that are warm in the winter and cool in the summer are more comfortable for individuals.

How Payment is Made

Payment for the audit must be made prior to the completion of the audit. Payment for the recommended energy measures must be made prior to any work or materials being ordered. Payment is to be made payable to the agency providing the assistance. Payment may be made by cash, cashier's check or money order. No payment is refundable.
