Diaper Assistance Program (DAP)

Rules & Eligibility Requirements

Am I eligible for DAP?

Your household must meet certain requirements to qualify for CADC's Diaper Assistance Program (DAP) and receive assistance. To qualify for the diaper program, you must:

- have a child or children in diapers
- meet income eligibility requirements (Please refer to page 2)
- present an ID/bill showing that you currently reside within your county

You must submit an application at your local CADC office. If CADC determines that you are eligible to receive DAP relieve, you can receive up to 3 packs of diapers collectively per pick up. Applicants are eligible for DAP pick up twice within a program; applicants are not eligible to receive more than 6 packs up diapers during the course of one program.

How do I apply for DAP?

You can apply for CADC's Diaper Assistance Program online or in person. To access a fillable DAP application, go to our website at <https://www.cadc.com/diaper-program>. To obtain a paper application, please visit your local CADC office. You will also need to submit a copy of your Driver's License, SSN, and proof of your previous month's income along with your application when applying.

What happens when I apply for DAP?

In most cases, once you submit a DAP application it is processed within 72 hours. You will be notified via e-mail updating you about your status.

When submitting your application, you will need to complete a distribution form and give proof (verification includes Proof of income, ID/utility bill, SSNs for applicant and children) of the information you provided. The distribution form is typically completed in-person or can printed off online. If you are found eligible, you will receive assistance. **Distribution amounts are contingent upon availability.**

How long will I receive DAP?

If you are found eligible, you will receive a notice that states you qualify to receive assistance twice within that program; The Diaper Assistance Program is open two times out of the year. **Please note that supplies is contingent upon availability.**

What are the DAP income limits?

DAP households must meet the monthly income limits or they are not eligible for DAP relief and cannot receive assistance.

Under Federal law, all income is counted to determine eligibility for DAP unless it is explicitly excluded. For DAP purposes, “income” includes both earned income such as wages and unearned income such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and veterans, disability, and death benefits. Because veterans’ and disability benefits are not explicitly excluded from income, they are counted when determining a household’s eligibility for DAP.

Where do I go to pick-up the diapers?

At this time, the Diaper Assistance Program is being exclusively offered to Clark, Miller, Saline, and Union County residents. If you are approved for DAP, you will pick up your diapers at your local CADC office. To locate where your local CADC office is, please visit <https://www.cadc.com/location-test>. Diapers will be available for pick-up **every Wednesday from 9-3pm** (Any changes regarding the schedule will be posted to our website). When picking up diapers, you will need to call the number associated with your CADC office. You must also bring a copy of your distribution form, Driver's License/Utility bill and you and your children's Social Security Card for us to verify your information.

Can someone pick-up the diapers for me?

In the event that you are unable to pick up your diapers on the day of pick-up, you can have someone else come pick them up in your place. The applicant must submit a signed letter authorizing the pickup. The letter must be submitted 24hrs prior to pick up. **The letter must contain the name of applicant, children for whom the diapers are for and the name of the person that will be picking the diapers up.**
